A superb buffet spread and wine is served by Captain Morgan's Chef and Stewards. We leave Comino cruising towards Dwejra to let Gorrot and San Blas Bay, soon after we cruise past Ramla l-Ittra with its peculiar reddish sand, your guide points out the legendary Calypso's Cave high up on the rocks as Ulysses saw it. Past Marsalforn Bay along the rock hewn salt pans and on to Wied Ġ' Ħsari. Next we go past Dwejra Point and the beautiful Dwejra Bay with its historical Fungus Rock. We leave Dwejra cruising towards Xlendi Bay past Ta' Ħenċ Cliffs approaching Mġarr ix-Xini, on towards the picturesque fishing port of Mġarr. The Fernandes departs from the Siġma Marina and cruises North westwards towards Gozo. We drop anchor in a secluded bay in Gozo at approximately 11.15 am. En-route one sees the panoramic cliffs, coves and inlets. The rest of the morning is spent swimming, snorkelling or relaxing on the large decks, while our stewards prepare a delicious buffet.
